4. Reception/Lunch/Dinner: You are invited to a Reception, two lunches, and two Dinners. 5. How to get to Reitaku?

Railway Option:

The Institute of Moralogy, located at Reitaku, provides a nice general overview of access information from Haneda/Narita airport to Reitaku at:

The closest station from the campus is "Minami-kashiwa" (南柏) on the JR Joban line or "Shin-Kashiwa" (新柏) on the Tobu Urban Park line. From Minami-Kashiwa or Shin-Kashiwa station, it takes about 20 minutes on foot or about 5 minutes by taxi.

If you are coming from **Tokyo**, take the JR Joban Line local service (directly linked to the Metro Chiyoda Line), and get off at Minami-Kashiwa Station. From Minami-Kashiwa, you can also take the Tobu bus (Bus Stop #1) at the East Exit; the ride takes about 5 minutes. Get off at "Reitaku Daigaku Mae" (麗澤大学前) station.

From Narita International Airport, you can schedule your way at the following site: Use "Minami-kashiwa" or "Shin-kashiwa" for destination. http://access.narita-airport.jp/en/index.html

From Narita Airport

Taxi: A taxi ride between Narita and Reitaku is about 19,900-20,080 yen, about 80 minutes.

Public Bus: There is a public bus/coach service from Narita Airport to Kashiwa station (90-100minutes, 1,700 yen one way) but it runs infrequently.

For timetables, go to http://www.nariku.co.jp/ and check Narita Express Buss "松戸·柏線:柏·柏の葉 方面(Kashiwa and Kashiwanoha). You can buy ticket at the Keisei bus counter (京成バスカウンター) at the arrival lobby. Get off at Kashiwa Station (the Crest Hotel) and from there take a taxi to Reitaku Campus Plaza (about 10 minutes, approx. 1,520–1,700 yen). Alternatively, from Kashiwa Station take a Joban Line train bound for Yoyoygi-Uehara to Minami-Kashiwa (just one stop).

From Haneda Airport

Taxi: A taxi ride between Haneda and Reitaku is about 16,000-20,000 yen, 50-90 min.

Public Bus & Railway: There is a public bus/coach service from Haneda Airport to Kameari station. You can find the details below. http://www.limousinebus.co.jp/en/platform_searches/index/4/129
You get off at Kameari (Kameari South Exit) and from there take JR Joban Line local service to Minami-kashiwa (about 20 min).
